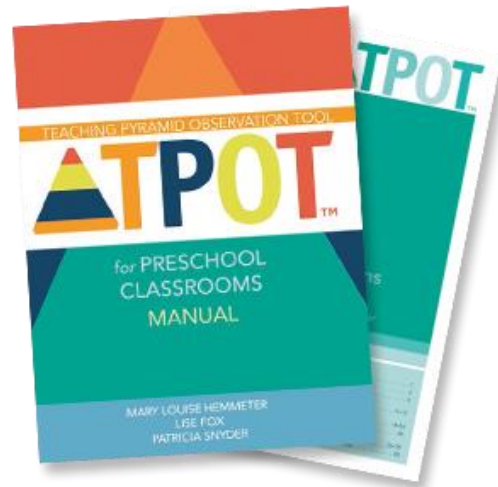

TRAINING DESCRIPTION:

The Teaching Pyramid Observation Tool (TPOT™) reliability training program prepares attendees to assess preschool teacher implementation of the Pyramid Model practices using the published version of the TPOT™ instrument. **This is an intensive workshop that requires prerequisite knowledge, preparation, and participation in the entire workshop.** Participants who successfully complete the workshop and meet reliability standards will receive a certificate indicating reliability status and can serve as reliability partners to other observers. Successful completion will indicate that the TPOT™ workshop participant is reliable with the instrument.
